
CERTIFICATION OF EXPERIENCE

Each person serving as a neutral in a Court ADR program shall be a member of the bar of this Court, a member of the faculty of an accredited law school, or be approved by this Court to serve as a neutral and be determined by a committee of Judges to be competent to perform the applicable duties, and shall participate in the court sponsored orientation session. Additional minimum requirements for serving on the Court's panel of neutrals, which the Court may modify in individual circumstances for good cause, are as follows:

Evaluators shall have been admitted to the



practice of law for at least 15 years and shall have:

- a. substantial experience with civil litigation in federal court;
- **b.** substantial expertise in the subject matter of the cases assigned to them; and
- **c.** the temperament and training to listen well, facilitate communication across party lines and, if called upon, assist the parties with settlement negotiations.

Arbitrators shall have been admitted to the practice of law
for at least 10 years and shall have:
a. For not less than five years, committed 50% or more of their
professional time to matters involving litigation; or
b. Substantial experience serving as a neutral in dispute resolution
proceedings.
c. Accept compensation set by Judicial Conference in accordance with
28 USC §658.
