Arnold, 232 F.3d 360, 374 (3d Cir. 2000); Kelly v. Del. River Joint Comm'n, 187 F.2d 93, 95 (3d Cir. 1951)). "[A] district court need not worry about amendment when the plaintiff does not properly request it." Fletcher-Harlee, 482 F.3d at 252. In other words, properly requesting leave to amend a complaint requires submitting a draft amended complaint. Id. Here, Plaintiff did not attach a proposed amended complaint to his motion for leave

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		to file an amended pleading. Under such circumstances and in light of the foregoing authority, Plaintiff did not properly request leave to file an amended complaint to assert § 1983 claims against newly identified defendants.
