LIEN ADMINISTRATOR APPOINTMENT ORDER

Pursuant to the uncontested motion and in accordance with the terms of the Personal Injury Master Settlement Agreement (“MSA” or the “Settlement”), the Court hereby appoints a Lien Administrator, as set forth in more detail below.

In the exercise of the Court’s authority to manage its docket and to ensure the timely and efficient performance of the actions necessary to satisfy the conditions of the Settlement, it is

ORDERED:

1. Wolf Global Compliance (“WGC”) is appointed as the Lien Administrator for the Settlement.
2. WGC shall be responsible for the duties set forth in the MSA assigned to the Lien Administrator, including the negotiation and resolution of Liens asserted by Lienholders, including global resolutions, and such other duties as Plaintiffs’ Negotiating Counsel and the Lien Administrator so agree.
3. WGC shall, after it has exhausted administrative efforts with any Lienholder to resolve groups of Liens globally, work on behalf of Registered Claimants with such Lienholder to negotiate and resolve such Liens on an individual basis.

4. For the avoidance of doubt, nothing herein is intended to imply that the Philips Defendants have any obligation or responsibility with respect to Liens arising from the MSA.

5. All costs and expenses for use of the Lien Administrator shall be paid by the Registered Claimants. The Philips Defendants shall not be responsible for any of the costs or expenses associated with the Lien Administrator beyond their two payments into the Settlement Fund, as described in the MSA.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
