Dear Ms. Clarke,

I write at your request in the case of Robert Bowers. I am board certified in Neurology, Psychiatry, Clinical Neurophysiology, Epilepsy, and Behavioral Neurology/Neuropsychiatry and until the end of February this year I was working at NYU School of Medicine both in Education Leadership Roles (program director of the combined residency in neurology and psychiatry, program director of the epilepsy research fellowship, and director of the neuroscience curriculum in psychiatry residency training) as well clinical roles with a large outpatient practice. I was asked to conduct a comprehensive neurological evaluation of Mr. Bowers, to assess his brain function and its relationship to his cognitive, psychiatric, neurological, and behavioral abilities and limitation. To assist in this, I had the opportunity to review extensive multigenerational, bio-psychosocial historic records (See Appendix A) as well as

conduct a clinical interview and physical examination in person. At my request, you also obtained brain imaging(PET and MRI), as well as 48 hour ambulatory EEG, discussed below in the addendum.

## Interview and Examination September 20, 2021

I had the opportunity to interview and examine Mr. Bowers in September 2021 the Butler County Prison. He was not shackled during my interview or examination, and we did not wear masks. We met in a very large, enclosed, private room with metal window shutters at the top of the walls which permitted air flow.

At the time of my interview and examination, Mr. Bowers was a 49 year old right handed imprisoned man.

## History of Present Illness:

Mr. Bowers is in pre-trial detention, accused of multiple murders, involving hate crimes and obstruction of free exercise of religious beliefs. He is not a good reporter of his own history, but he was willing, forthright, and engaged in answering questions throughout my assessment with him. He reported his neuropsychiatric history as follows.

At a very young age, around 6 or 7 years old he twice had a high fever with delirium and hallucinations (he saw walls moving and beach balls were coming at him at a very rapid speed). He associated these experiences with eating in a restaurant, although no one else had similar symptoms. In elementary school he had a concussion with loss of consciousness when he was running and hit his head on the bleachers. He does not recall what happened, but said that he remembered waking with everyone around him and that his mother had to wake him regularly through the night and ask him questions. He reports believing that it is harder for him to remember people's names now than previously, and that it is harder to multi-task. For instance, he indicated that he can no longer read with music playing in the background. He has a chronic issue with tingling in his left middle toe. He has a delusion that red ink is leaking from his clothes, into his body, and then comes out of his body into his plastic wristband which turns redder and redder as the month progresses and then gets transferred to one of his pens. He has had an episode of

"sleep paralysis," where he awoke but could not move for 2-3 minutes. He reported difficulty with finding words. He has had a panic attack while driving in New Jersey, which he mentioned in response to hearing where I live. His sleep is irregular and intermittent. It was similar when he was driving a truck. He described preferring to be awake at night and asleep during the day, but he sleeps throughout the day currently, napping and dozing. He described himself as an introvert.

He is restricted in his topics of conversation; his affect is generally flat; his thinking is rigid and concrete; he perseverates on topics, returning to them after he switched to other topics; he has difficulty expressing concepts or explaining his thinking; and he has deficits in theory of mind. Theory of mind refers to the ability to understand other people's mental states, actions and beliefs as similar or distinct from one's own, and to understand the relationship between one's self and others. It is a social reasoning ability which typically develops early in childhood and shapes social behavior through out life. It is closely linked to the mirror neuron system in the brain that allows us to imagine that others have an independent mind with independent thoughts, emotions, motivations, etc. In addition, he discussed his somatic delusion that red ink is leaking from his clothes, into his body, and then coming out of his body into his plastic wristband which turns redder and redder over time and also gets transferred to one of his pens, but not his cup.

In our meeting he spent a lot of time on numbers and passwords from the past, his own and others. He noted that the password to his mother's very old Linux computer, one of her early computers, was xrc4771sQ!. He set up the password for her. He remembers various people's license plate numbers like his mother and prior girlfriend's and produced the following license plate numbers: SSF 773 (mother's old car), VBA 753, X3K 359, YYK 028. He knows his Grandfather's ATM code from when he helped to take care of him and states he knows many other passwords and numbers of his family. He remembers he was on highway 287 and route 1-9 in New Jersey when he had his panic attack. He was excessively focused on talking about computers and trucking. He notes that he had an Apple IIE in 1981, then jumped over to an Omega computer and then two IBM PC's in 1994. He reports he "can design things," and can draw circuit diagrams.

He detailed being in three fights in his life. The first was because he was being bullied. A second was with someone with whom his girlfriend was cheating. The third was because his best friend got in a fight and he felt he needed to be loyal and help him. He states he did not have many friends. One really. Records reveal

that he was isolated and depressed as a youth, at least starting in middle school. He told me that he considered suicide every day in childhood and adolescence. He was hungry and depressed constantly. He slept in school because he could not sleep at home. This was the result of his having to be constantly aware of what his mother might do next and the constant screaming and arguing. He wanted to get away from his mother and suicide was always one of the options for him. Records indicate that he made 6 suicide attempts or gestures, the first at age 10 years old. He has sensory issues and cannot stand when his beard gets itchy. It "drives me crazy." He noted that in dreams people he knows are in color and people he doesn't know are in black and white.

Substance use history: he has tried cocaine, weed, acid, sniffed heroin to treat back pain. First alcohol use was at age 10 or 11. Little liquor bottles. Only drank once in high school as he was the designated driver. He has blacked out from drinking in the past. He experimented with several substances in his early 20's. He used pain medication (Lortab) which he ordered online for pain management for about three years after back injury at the bakery where he worked.

He acknowledged two suicide attempts/gestures, once trying to drink grain alcohol at the age of 17, when he lit himself on fire, and another when he was older when he put a loaded shotgun in his mouth but aborted the attempt and called the police at which time he was taken to a hospital. He described that he felt he had no options, was losing his job and the apartment that went with it, and could not think of any alternatives. He also reports an episode at age 17 where he "took a bunch of aspirin and sleeping pills," but never presented to a hospital.

Past Medical History: multiple ear infections.

Past Surgical History: Gunshot wounds related to the charged offenses in his current case, his left lower leg broken and casted after a sled run accident.

Family History: His biological father suicided when Robert was approximately 6 or 7 years old, although he was no longer living with Robert, having left Robert's mother when Robert was about 2 years old. Multiple members of his mother's family have or were diagnosed with mood disorders, substance use disorders and dementia.

Past Psychiatric History: Robert was admitted to in-patient psychiatric units on multiple occasions. He was treated with Thorazine and Imipramine. He was twice referred by school teachers for psychotherapy. The first time, his mother found out he had been referred and pulled him out. The second time she refused to allow him to go. After a fight with his mother, he threatened to light his mother on fire and was sent to residential psychiatric treatment.

Developmental/Social History: Robert was born and raised in the suburbs outside Pittsburgh. He self-reported his childhood as "up until 9 it was all right." From 9 to 17 was "a problem." Words used to describe this time were "conflict" and "broke." Finished 11th grade, but had to repeat it because he spent part of that year as an inpatient. His home life was so chaotic that he did not sleep well at home and slept at school. His mother was constantly riding him. For example he had a watch that he set in 24 hour mode and she got convinced that the alarm was set in 24 hour mode but not the clock. She was absolutely sure she was right even though she was wrong. She refused to admit to being wrong. He said he had a few friends in the '90's who he would see at a bar maybe twice a month. He had one close friend who he had known since childhood until his death in 2016. Joe was into computers, motorcycles, and guns. Robert was never married, and has no kids. He was actually never homeless, although he did often sleep in his truck or stayed in relatives' houses. He did have a period where he "didn't have any keys." He worked various jobs, but primarily in the bakery where his grandfather got him a job driving a delivery truck and in big-rig trucking.

Allergies: His mother thinks he is allergic to something, but he can't remember.

Medications: No prescribed medication in the past 15-20 years.

## **Neural Examination:**

**Mental Status Examination**: His Montreal Cognitive Assessment (MOCA) score was 27/30 as he missed three of five words when asked to recall them shortly after seeing them. He appears to have a very detail oriented memory and appears to visualize his memories in detail. He is concrete and nonchalant in his approach to tasks, but he tried hard and continued to work on tasks, even when he was very slow at the task. He had great difficulty with abstraction.

Appearance/Comportment: He was well groomed wearing a prison jumpsuit. He was cooperative and forthright, with normal speech and reduced eye contact. Psychomotor activity was neutral to reduced.

Mood: "ok."

Affect: Flat, rigid, and indifferent.

Thought Content: Robert is thought disordered. His thinking is restricted and abnormally detailed. He is hyper-focused on numbers, computers. He has no current suicidal or homicidal ideation. He has delusions, including that of red ink leaching into his body from his clothes. He denied hallucinations currently, but also said that he sometimes saw something moving out of the corner of his eye, but when he turned there was not anything there. Similarly, he sometimes hears things but thinks it is probably just noises in the jail or mice because nothing is there when he looks. He was somewhat obsessive and repetitive in what he wanted to talk about and topics he returned to despite the discussion having moved to another topic.

Thought Process: Restricted. Abulic. Unable to initiate thoughts easily. Slowed. Sequential but often not relevant. Concrete and has difficulty abstracting, focuses on unimportant details and has trouble "seeing the forest for the trees."

Cognition: as above (MOCA), but also noted to have significant difficulty abstracting. Concrete.

Insight: very poor.

Judgment: very poor.

**Cranial Nerves**: 2-12 normal, except for anosmia with two separate samples in each nare separately

**Motor**: Bilateral fine tremor on sustention and action (drawing) in right hand more than left. Decreased hopping on left leg. Decreased fine finger movements bilaterally with

elements of dyspraxia and limb-kinetic apraxia (difficulty in the smoothness of fine motor movements in the hands not related to true weakness).

**Sensory**: Decreased vibration in a glove and stocking distribution up to the knees and even at the fingers. 50-60% at knees and 70% at fingers. Light touch intact, pain and temperature senses intact.

Coordination: action tremor

Gait: normal tandem gait

Romberg negative

Frontal Release Signs: Left palmomental sign present

Babinski Sign present on the right (Right toe upgoing)

**Reflexes:** Pathologic hyperreflexia at the left biceps at 3+, as well as reduced deep tendon reflexes at the bilateral triceps 1+, and absent ankle jerk reflexes

#### Impression:

Mr. Bowers is a 49 year old man accused of multiple murders. Record review as well as interview and examination of him reveal marked cerebral dysfunction that is longstanding. Evidence of this dysfunction includes:

1. Markedly abnormal electroencephalogram (EEG) showing extensive cerebral dysfunction both diffuse and focal temporal and frontotemporal. This is a strong predictor for epilepsy. People with Temporal Intermittent Rhythmic Delta Activity and epileptiform discharges in one temporal lobe have an approximately 95% likelihood of having seizures in their lives. Lack of history of a witnessed seizure does not preclude epilepsy. His EEG reveals focal abnormalities, epileptiform discharges and slowing in both temporal regions, more prominent in the left temporal region, as well as generalized diffuse slowing of the background waveforms.

- 2. His neural examination reveals frontal lobe dysfunction (left palmomental sign, right Babinski sign, abulia).
- 3. PET Scan of the brain revealed abnormal functioning, with mild to moderately decreased metabolism in the cerebellum, hypothalamus, brainstem and pons, as well as the right caudate, globus pallidus, parahippocampus, and the left amygdala. It also revealed abnormally increased metabolism in the frontal regions which included the left middle frontal gyrus, bilateral inferior medial frontal gyri, bilateral superior medial frontal gyri, bilateral olfactory cortices, and bilateral gyri recti, as well as in the left superior temporal gyrus and right subcallosal region.
- 4. MRI scan of the brain demonstrated significant asymmetry of the hippocampi (left smaller than right), caudate and putamen (left smaller than right), as well as ventricular asymmetries suggesting volume lose more on the right side globally. It also showed white matter lesions throughout his brain. This is based on the NeuroQuant MRI evaluation.

His overall picture is one of a person with a developmental and chronic psychotic disorder and attendant epilepsy. His manner is odd, he has a thought disorder and the negative symptoms of schizophrenia, as well as delusions. He has spent much of his life with limited contact with family and few friends, opting for a solitary profession of truck driving. He has substantial difficulty initiating topics for discussion and a restricted range of topics he brings up. He often says that he simply is unable to explain his thinking or how he came to believe something. This is a sort of developmental delay where epilepsy and psychosis can often be seen as I believe is the case with Mr. Bowers. Given the widespread abnormalities in his brain it is evident that he has a psychotic condition that has been longstanding, namely Schizophrenia, as well as epilepsy which likely has affected his brains development as well. Ample evidence of dysfunction in frontal and limbic (temporal) systems with attendant epileptogenicity on his EEG in the picture, as well as active psychosis, makes it impossible for him to assess stimuli or read the world appropriately; he is unable to make proper decisions using proper judgment, based on his delusional beliefs and his inability to accurately perceive the world around him or his relationship

to it. He is quick to agitation, especially regarding his mother's behavior from 30 or more years ago, becoming loud and pressured in his descriptions, growing angry and frustrated as if he was re-experiencing the event in the moment of retelling it.

In addition, it is particularly important to note, that beyond suffering from Schizophrenia, Mr. Bowers also suffers from untreated epilepsy. The chronic sequelae of untreated epilepsy include frontal system dysfunction, including deficits in executive functioning like decision making, judgment, inhibition and temporal lobe dysfunction including emotional processing and emotional labeling of stimuli. There are both emotional (limbic) and cognitive (frontal) deficits in epilepsy even when it is treated over time. When undiagnosed and untreated these epileptic networks in their widespread ramifications can affect several parts of the brain, something that is further supported by PET scan, MRI, EEG, and neuropsychological testing in Mr. Bower's case. These frontotemporal deficits make it impossible to consistently assess stimuli appropriately and to make appropriate decisions in regards to those stimuli. In untreated epilepsy there often develops a certain deal of rigidity in thinking and belief and a tendency toward black and white thinking. These deficits exacerbate similar problems in Schizophrenia in the natural course of its illness. In fact, there is a history of considering temporal lobe epilepsy and Schizophrenia related illnesses, with kindling of medial temporal structures and overlapping symptoms. The combination of both of these together is synergistically, and therefore more harmful than having each independently.

To a reasonable degree of medical certainty, it is my opinion that Mr. Bowers is a person with Schizophrenia and Epilepsy, and that these are longstanding conditions, rendering him incapable of assessing risks and consequences of his behavior, nor making appropriate judgments in its regard.

This position is amply supported by all the objective testing Mr. Bowers has undergone, structural (MRI), neurophysiological (EEG), and functionally (Neurologic Examination, PET scan, and Neuropsychological testing), all of which reveal a markedly abnormal brain,








Left Frontotemporal slowing with sharp contour.




Left temporal slowing.




Bitemporal, left greater than right slowing (in brackets).




Bilateral frontal slowing.




Bilateral frontal slowing.




Bilateral frontotemporal slowing.




Right frontotemporal epileptiform sharp wave in sleep.




Bitemporal, right more than left epileptiform discharge embedded in sleep.




Sharply contoured left temporal slowing.




Left more than right frontotemporal slowing.




Bilateral frontotemporal slowing with sharp contour.




Bilateral frontotemporal slowing with sharp contour.




Left frontocentral slowing.







## Appendix A:

Here are records that I have reviewed:

- 1. **Neurologic Family History Tree** multiple members of his mother's family suffered from dementia and Parkinson's disease. Father suicided at the age of 27 y.o.
- 2. Chronological Family History and Bower's records Summary
- 3. Protective Order United States District Court Western District of Pennsylvania
- 4. **Allegheny Health Network Records 10/27-30/2018** Multiple gunshot wounds and treatment. CT head without intracranial hemorrhage. Gunshot wounds to left chest and arm as well as left lower extremity.
- 5. **McKeesport Hospital Records 9/24/85-10/10/85**: Psychiatric admission for aggressive behavior, holding aerosol can and lighter, threatening to light fire and burn an older boy and his mother. Diagnoses: Depression, chronic and "adolescent adjustment reaction." CT of the head was negative at this admission. He was treated with Thorazine. He was thirteen. Note is made of a suicide attempt at age 10 years old, but details are not provided. Note is made that his mother yelled at him a lot. He stated he "hates school and has very few friends...." Noted that he did not see his behavior as abnormal and did not express remorse. Some statements of wanting to get his stuff back or would do \$20 worth of damage. Noted to not display emotion during these statements. Eventually did better, more social, and felt to be safe and discharged.
- 6. **Suicide Note of Randall George Bowers**. October 1979. Date of Death: October 15, 1979. Self-inflicted gunshot wound to chest. Noted to be fearful of doing jailtime for a crime committed in Pittsburgh and what would happen to him in jail.

## 7. Military Records:

a. Psychiatric Admission: 1/9/1975-2/4/1975: Second admission for "Air Force Sergeant who comes in for anger, anxiety, and depression." Two months prior had another admission for "being hit on the head by a 2x4." Evaluated by neurology. Exam was normal but there was report of pain and tenderness in the left temporal area. At that admission he was noted to have an episode of "psychogenic unresponsiveness for which he declares amnesia following the incident...." [more likely temporal lobe seizure given EEG]. He was noted to be violent after that episode requiring restraints and then "became cooperative after a short time." [post-ictal resolution]. Mental status examination then revealed a thought process that was "tangential, circumstantial, and, at one point, they were frankly loose." [post-ictal?]. Diagnosis was "severe character and behavior

disorder of hysterical type...." Discharged and "did fairly well," till February 1975 when he started having increasing "interpersonal difficulty with his wife." Note is made of a prior hospitalization at Valparaiso, Indiana for 8 days for a "nervous breakdown." Robert noted that his father was homosexual and that his father drank heavily and beat other members of his family. Note is made of closeness with his mother and a "nearly symbiotic" relationship. Worked as a civil engineer and operated heavy machinery. He complains of severe chronic headaches and EEG, "brain scan,' CBC., urinalysis, and skull x-rays were "all negative." Note is made of anxiety and pressure in his head. He is noted to be "on the verge of tears" much of the time. "Illogical, confused, and incoherent." + "ideas of reference" feeling people were talking about him. Marked anger at his wife and statements of wishes of harm. Fearful of his doctor, other patients, and his own potential. Psychological testing was carried out on February 2, 1976: IQ 93, "impairment of perceptual motor functions. "There is no indication of abstract reasoning." Suggested "borderline" schizophrenia in a severe character and behavior disorder 'hysterical type," as well as "somatic delusions." "...the above testing conforms with my clinical impression of latent schizophrenia with somatic delusions of headache in a severely hysterical character." Note is made of "no capacity for insight," and that he was often superficial and silly in group therapy. Diagnoses: Schizophrenia latent type with "hysterical conversion symptoms, confusion, lability of mood, and incoherence;" Character and behavior disorder with mixed personality traits of passive-dependent, passive-aggressive and hysterical character, severe, chronic.

- b. USAF Regional Hospital Psychiatric Service Admission November 7-12, 1975. Initially admitted to Neurology service for headache after "minor head injury." The persistence of the headache without anatomic correlate and negative work-up (bloodwork, skull x-ray, EEG) made the consulting psychiatrist think his condition was due to "severe character pathology." Statement is made that he is "temperamentally and emotionally unsuited for continued service in the Air Force. These are the opinions of William Walters II, Chief Psychiatric Services, Lt. Col, USAF.
- 8. **Mercy Hospital, Pittsburgh Medical Records 6/30/2006 3/16/2011**: Initial contact with Pittsburgh Internal Medicine Associates request for disability form to be filled out. Robert noted he was unable to hold down a job "secondary to tremendous depression, anxiety, and social anxieties." Note is made that he very infrequently leaves his home. Admitted to a suicide attempt at the age of 17 years old, overdosing on pills, but could not remember the type of pills. Dr.

- Tomaro, D.O. prescribed Effexor and referred him to a psychiatrist. Later intermittent visits note back pain a few times and lumbar strain.
- 9. **University of Pittsburgh Medical Center Records of Lloyd Jenkins**. 11/24/2014-12/10/2014. Admitted for Urinary Tract Infection, Sepsis, delirium, hypotension, acute respiratory failure, left sided thalamic hemorrhage. ICU stay. Atrial fibrillation developed as well as septic shock requiring intubation. Brain scans revealed an evolving left thalamic hemorrhage and extensive volume loss. Eventually transferred to inpatient hospice.
- 10. **Allegheny Health Records of Patricia Fine**. Admitted for seizure with a history of epilepsy and prior stroke. Focal seizure involving right hemibody is described. Head CT noted to be unremarkable. Question is made of "psychogenic flavor to her exam," and there was a question of whether the spells were focal epileptic seizures or psychogenic seizures. Keppra, her antiseizure medication, was increased in dose and she was discharged.
- 11. **Allegheny Health Network Canonsburg Hospital Records of Lloyd Jenkins** 11/2014. Presented with shortness of breath and was found to have urinary tract infection and sepsis and transferred to University of Pittsburgh (see # 9 above).
- 12. County of Allegheny Autopsy Report by Baiyang Xu, MD on Joseph Sedley. Cause of death: "combined toxic effects of heroin, U-47700, Codeine, and diazepam."
- 13. Federal Drug Testing and Control Forms 5/28/2018, 7/28/2008, 9/22/2008,
- 14. **Vehicle Lease Agreement for Robert Bowers** 11/2018 Hyundai notice of lease expiration and late payments and non-return of vehicle.
- 15. Obituary of Robert Dennis in The Evening Review (Liverpool, Ohio) 5/21/2945.
- 16. **Baldwin Borough Police Department** 1/30/1089: Barbara Saiter, mother of Robert called the police on her 16 year old son. She noted that he became "very upset" with her after she found a note with a phone number on it, and Robert started chasing her out of the apartment. She ran to a neighbor's house and called the police. By the time they arrived her fiancé noted that Robert was calm and in control and police were not needed. 1/31/1989: Police note is made that Ms. Saiter went to St. John's Hospital and received a "302" commitment for her son Robert. He was transported to the hospital by the police.
- 17. **Death Certificate of William Edgar Lutton** Date of Death 8/17/1956 from metastatic seminoma. Occupation listed as Coal Miner.
- 18. **Certificate of Completion for CI Truck Driver Training** for Robert on 10/10/2008.
