Judge Deller will discuss significant cases of the region, such as Allegheny International, the steel bankruptcy cases, the bankruptcy implications arising out of the murder of legendary architect Stanford White and the homicide trial of Henry Thaw, Heinz & Noble, Jeannette Glass, Pittsburgh Brewing, and the Westinghouse Receivership, and how these and other cases affected (or reflected) the financial conditions of the District.
