



## WHAT IS PAY.GOV?

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*Pay.gov is the convenient and fast way to make secure electronic payments to Federal Government Agencies.*

### **Benefits of using Pay.gov**

*No more paper, stamps or delay in the mail. Payments can be submitted on-line anytime and anywhere with internet access. Payments can be made on-line 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You can make one-time payments or establish recurring payments (**direct debit only**).*

### **Ways to Pay your Debt**

**Debit Card.** *One-time payments can be made using Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express debit cards.*

**Checking or Savings Account.** *One-time or recurring payments can be made using business or personal checking and savings accounts.*

**NOTE:** *Maximum payment amount per transaction is \$5,000.00.*

## Where Can I Make my On-line Payment?

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Users can make payments on-line by visiting the court's website at [www.pawd.uscourts.gov](http://www.pawd.uscourts.gov). This website is accessible by any computer, tablet or mobile device with an internet connection. Once you are at the court's website you will be redirected to the pay.gov website to make your payment.

**PLEASE NOTE: If internet access is prohibited pursuant to your criminal judgment, you may not use this service.**

## How Do I Pay On-line?

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**Step 1:** Obtain your court case number and defendant number (ex: 2:20-cr-750-3) from either your US Probation Officer, your monthly statement or contact the U.S. District Court Clerk's Office.

**Step 2:** In your internet browser, go to the Court's website at [www.pawd.uscourts.gov](http://www.pawd.uscourts.gov)

**Step 3:** On the left side of the court's home page click **Payments**, then click **Criminal Debt Payments**. Read the instructions, and then click on the button, **Continue to the Form**.

You will now be able to access the court's payment form and make your payment.

**Step 4:** Enter your personal information on the form. Enter your case defendant number in the appropriate box (ex: 2:20-cr-750-3), and payment amount. Click **Continue**.

**Step 5:** Enter your payment information and click **Submit**. Follow the instructions to finalize your payment.
