
**ORDER OF COURT REGARDING ASSIGNMENT OF SOCIAL SECURITY CASES**

**AND NOW**, in accordance with LCvR 40(F), which states, “all actions qualifying for the Erie or Johnstown calendars shall be assigned to the Judges designated by the Court to hear such actions,” and in the interest of efficient and orderly administration of justice,

**IT IS ORDERED** that for the purposes of all social security cases filed in the District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania, all District Judges, Senior District Judges, and full-time Magistrate Judges are deemed to be designated by the Court to hear such actions regardless of their duty station.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any social security case filed on or after April 1, 2025 shall be randomly assigned by the Clerk.
