## **ORDER REASSIGNING CERTAIN CIVIL ACTIONS**

**AND NOW**, this 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 2026, after due consideration and in furtherance of the continued sound management of the Court's dockets and to continue to facilitate the just determination of every proceeding, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 137(a), LCvR 40(F) and Administrative Order 2025-24, and


Upon this Court's finding that the volume of cases being filed in the Johnstown Division by individuals who are, or have been, detained at the Moshannon Valley Processing Center, a U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Detention Facility, arising out of, related to, or regarding said detention (hereafter referred to as "Moshannon Cases"), presents exceptional circumstances and raises unanticipated case assignment and management issues of an emergency nature,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, effective January 20, 2026, and continuing until the end of the calendar year, all Moshannon Cases, will be randomly assigned to the following judicial officers only:

The United States District Judge who is resident in the Johnstown Division; and  
Those United States District Judges who are resident in the Pittsburgh Division  
and have been specifically designated, by Administrative Order, to receive  
assignment of Moshannon Cases.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the following District Judges are hereby designated to receive assignment of Moshannon Cases filed on or after January 20, 2026: District Judge Stephanie L. Haines, District Judge J. Nicholas Ranjan, District Judge William S. Stickman, IV, and District Judge Christy Criswell Wiegand.
