
Upon this Court’s finding that Administrative Order 2026-01, which provided for the assignment of cases filed by individuals who are, or have been, detained at the Moshannon Valley Processing Center, a U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement Detention Facility, (“Moshannon”), arising out of, related to, or regarding said detention, is no longer adequate to address the exceptional circumstances and unanticipated and emergency case assignment and management issues set forth in that Order because individuals are now being detained at locations other than Moshannon that are within the jurisdiction of this Court, or are being released with conditions such as electronic or GPS monitoring within the jurisdiction of this Court,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, effective retroactively to January 20, 2026, and continuing until the end of the calendar year, any Prisoner Petition-Habeas Corpus Alien Detainee case (Nature of Suit 463) filed in any division of this Court will be assigned in the

same manner as Moshannon Cases have been and continue to be assigned pursuant to Administrative Order 2026-01.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Administrative Order supplements Administrative Order 2026-01, together with any subsequent orders amending, supplementing, or superseding Administrative 2026-01.
