AMENDED ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 6th day of ~~April~~ ^{June}, 2001, pursuant to the resolution of the Board of Judges,

IT IS ORDERED that a fee in the sum of \$40.00 shall be charged for each pro hoc vice admission to the bar of this court effective May 1, 1999.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall be charged with the responsibility of collecting the fee from each applicant for pro hoc vice admission and shall deposit the funds in a separate account in the Court Library Fund, maintained by the Clerk of Court.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the funds generated from such admissions shall be utilized by the court for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of counsel who are appointed by the judges of the district court to represent indigent plaintiffs in prisoner civil rights cases, or for any other authorized use of non-appropriated funds which benefits both the bench and the bar.


IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that the authority to appoint counsel in appropriate pro se prisoner's civil rights actions under the plan adopted by this court shall rest with the judges of the district court and, if a magistrate judge concludes that counsel should be appointed


in a particular case, the magistrate judge shall submit a report and recommendation to the district court judge to whom the civil action is assigned for approval.


