ORDER

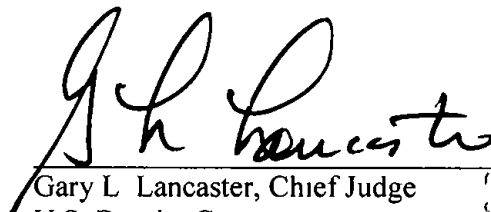
WHEREAS, on April 20, 2005 the Court established by order at Misc 05-186, an Electronic Case Filing System and adopted Electronic Case filing Policies and Procedures to govern the program, which made electronic filing mandatory in this district

WHEREAS, effective May 6, 2006, The National Archives and Record Administration (NARA) has approved the records disposition authority that permits the immediate disposal of paper documents scanned in the Case Management/Electronic Case File (CM/ECF) system

WHEREAS, paper documents filed January 1, 2005 through June 30, 2005, in cases initiated during the same time period, in all three divisions, have been scanned into the CM/ECF system and have been verified and quality controlled

NOW THEREFORE IT IS SO ORDERED, that all paper records scanned into the CM/ECF, shall no longer be retained and that the Clerk of Court shall dispose of said paper records
